ALPOA Beach Parking Passes

To prevent the use of the beaches by non-ALPOA members, beach-parking passes will be required again this year. Attach it to your mirror when you park at either beach. If you need a new beach pass, please contact Ann Milner at 860-884-5643 for a replacement. ALPOA property owners need to accompany guests when using Sunset and East Beaches. No property owner has a right to issue an open invitation to non-resident friends or acquaintances to use our lake or beaches.

If a car has no beach pass, a letter will be placed on the windshield reminding them this is a private beach. State police could be called if a car is parked without a pass a second time. It is the responsibility of all ALPOA members to monitor this situation.

The Board will continue to work diligently to protect the privacy and rights of ALPOA members who use the beaches; but we need help from the community. It has been suggested that a community watch subcommittee be formed to deal exclusively with beach matters. Please contact a Board member if you are willing to support our community in this area.
